"I wanted the living room to honor the garden and yet represent the formal entertaining for which both the Fairchild and Sweeney families were renowned," Hillary Littlejohn Scurtis says. "When thinking of my dream team to transform this room, Monica James came to mind first because of her very discerning eye and her dynamic collection of bespoke furnishings, lighting and accessories at her namesake store. Monica and I consulted on everything from the wallpaper, which is Coffering by Paulo Werneck, printed by Studio Printworks, to the length of the sofas by George Smith to the weave of the rugs, made for this project by Elizabeth Eakins. All of the furniture was either ordered for the room by Monica or was tapped from her treasure of inventory at her store and warehouse. Dennis Shah from Studio Printworks printed the paper custom so it would be scaled to the tray ceiling. Karen Boyer from Elements in Play Fine Art Advisory curated all the art—specifically the Peter Peri, Elisabeth Condon and Fredric Snitzer—which gave the room context and anchored the large walls."
